Dear EAA Members,





Report from ECA2024



The 13th European Congress of Andrology (ECA2024) was held on 4-6 September 2024 in Stockholm, Sweden. Two accompanying educational events preceded the Congress.

Andrology Day 2024

The event, organised by the Swedish Society of Andrology, was held at the Karolinska Institute. The agenda covered various aspects pertaining to male health, including testosterone deficiency, the long-term effects of childhood cancer treatment in men, reproductive health, and male contraception. The speakers presented talks in English and Swedish. The event was open to the general public and was well attended.

The ANDRONET-EAA Course for Andrologists



The EAA organised jointly with the ANDRONET COST Action a pre-Congress Course: "What should the andrologist know in 2024", which was held on 4 Sept 2024 at the venue just before the start of the Congress.

The course was moderated jointly by the ANDRONET leader Rafael Oliva and two clinical co-Chairs of the POC; Francesco Lombardo and Zsolt Kopa. The faculty included eight POC members, and the interesting programme covered clinical and basic hot topics in andrology.

The main Congress

The ECA2024 was organised by the local organising committee (LOC), led by Jan-Bernd Stukenborg, Mats Holmberg, Lars Björndahl and João P. Alves-Lopes, as well as the professional congress organizers Asszisztencia, known to all EAA members as the EAA Office service providers. The comfortable venue in the old brewery on a hill overlooking the heart of Stockholm, and a perfect sunny weather contributed to the fantastic atmosphere at the ECA.

At the core of the ECA was the scientific programme, comprising multiple symposia running in three parallel tracks: clinical and translational andrology, uro-andrology and basic science in andrology (see the box below).



The high-profile plenary lecturers presented excellent talks on basic or translational discoveries: Luca Jovine, Peter Y. Liu (ASA-EAA lecture), Anna-Maria Andersson (ESE-EAA lecture), Steven Ramm, Joris Veltman, and on the current clinical conundrums: Giovanni Corona (ESSM-EAA lecture), Sabine Kliesch & Philippa Sangster.

The abstract submissions broke the ECA records and provided a great overview of current state of andrology in Europe and beyond (published in Andrology). The three best abstracts selected by the POC were presented at the opening session as "Golden Oral Communications" by Francesco Lotti (clinical), J. Richard Pilsner (translational) and Viola H. Lobert (basic). Collaborating European societies, ESAU and ESHRE, held special sessions focused on andrological urology and fertility preservation, respectively.

The Network of Young Researchers in Andrology (NYRA), participated for the first time as a part of the EAA, and organised a dedicated NYRA session focused on basic aspects of male reproduction. The session opened with an excellent talk given by Lena Arévalo (E), the 2024 recipient of the annual NYRA Young Investigator Award.

Two well-attended poster sessions provided additional opportunities to young andrologists to present and discuss their projects. Ten excellent posters received EAA-sponsored best posters awards (Isabel Andersson, Kristina Fagerkvist, Daniela Fietz, Muriel Heitsch, Katarzyna Marchlewska, Gina Esther Merges, Hans Christian Schuppe, Johanna Steingröver, Tamas Takacs, Peter Zarén), which were announced at the Closing Ceremony, together with numerous travel grants issued by the EAA and the International Society of Andrology (ISA). The Executive Council uses this opportunity to thank these societies and express gratitude to Rafael Oliva and the leaders of the ANDRONET COST Action for supporting the travel of more than 90 participants.

The ECA was also a great opportunity for informal networking, with an excellent social programme.

The undisputed highlight was a festive Welcome Reception in the Stockholm City Hall – a historical landmark and the place of Nobel prize celebrations., made possible by the gracious support of the City of Stockholm.

EAA General Assembly

The EAA held the General Assembly in connection with the ECA in Stockholm, on 5 September 2024.

Activity Reports. The busy agenda included reports of the activities of the EAA Officers and the Executive Council; President Hermann Behre, Secretary Ewa Rajpert-De Meyts and Treasurer Davor Ježek. The EAA financial report was approved by two Auditors, Andreas Meinhardt and Jan-Bernd Stukenborg, and the Assembly. The Auditors kindly agreed to serve for two more years. Subsequently, Aleksander Giwercman (Chief Editor of Andrology) presented the latest achievements of the journal, and the (co) Chairs of several committees presented short reports: Csilla Krausz (Accreditation and Examinations), Zsolt Kopa (Education) and Giovanni Corona (Clinical Guidelines). Paulo Navarro Costa summarised the EMQN collaboration. The President of NYRA, Alberto de la Iglesia presented a brief report on the network's impressive activities during the transition period since the NYRA-EAA merger pre-approvement in 2022. He introduced the new Executive Board (2024-26), with Daniel Marcu taking over the NYRA Presidency.

Statutes Revision. The EAA Secretary, Ewa Rajpert-De Meyts, presented proposed changes in the EAA Statutes (Bylaws), with the most important points concerning creating a new NYRA-EAA membership category for young researchers in training, and adding the NYRA President as an ex-officio member of the Executive Council, which should also have flexibility regarding the member number. The proposals were approved unanimously by the General Assembly.

Renewal of the Executive Council. Ewa Rajpert-De Meyts stepped down after 6 years of service as the Secretary, and the General Assembly approved unanimously her successor, Giovanni Corona of Bologna.

New Honorary Members of EAA

At the Opening Ceremony of the ECA2024 in Stockholm, two scientists were distinguished with honorary EAA memberships for their long service:

- Jorma Toppari former EAA President (2010–14), and the Chief Editor of the *Int. J. Androl.* (2001–09), who served on the EAA Executive Council for 22 years. He is a prominent clinical and basic scientist in the field of paediatric endocrinology and andrology.
- Ewa Rajpert-De Meyts the last Chief Editor of *Int J. Androl.* (2009–12), the first co-Editor of *Andrology* (2012–16), and a former EAA Secretary (2018–24). She is known in the field of developmental aspects of testis disorders, especially testicular cancer.

A face-to-face meeting of the EAA-Training Centres Directors was held on the eve of the ECA on 3 Sept. 2024. After the welcome address by EAA President Hermann Behre, Csilla Krausz, the Chair of the Accreditation Committee, summarised the recent activities of the Committee, including resuming site visits interrupted and postponed in recent years during the COVID-19 crisis. She was happy to announce that in 2024 the EAA accredited a new EAA-Training Centre in Naples (Italy) led by Prof. Rosario Pivonello.

Goulis. Among the articles, the issue contains the important clinical practice guidelines on male contraception, commissioned and endorsed jointly by the EAA and the American Society of Andrology (ASA).

A new special issue currently open for submissions: *Testicular Cancer*, guest editors: Kristian Almstrup (DK) and Ludmila Boublikova (CZ).



Editorial Assistants

The Boards of the EAA and ASA have decided to support part-time editorial assistants for the Chief Editor and the Deputy Editor (Wei Yan), who will be located on the two sides of the Atlantic. The assistants will help with running the review process, solicitate new special issue ideas, promote the journal and establish *Andrology* on relevant social media platforms.

The 17th NYRA Meeting. The annual NYRA meeting will take place on 12-13 April 2025, in connection with the European Testis Workshop (ETW2025), in De Ruwenberg, the Netherlands.

Reports from EAA Schools

8th Edition of the EAA Ultrasound School

The oldest EAA Ultrasound School, dedicated to educating high-quality level operators in the ultrasound of male genital tract and penile ultrasound, was again organised by Francesco Lotti and Andrea Isidori in the EAA Training Centres of Florence and Rome, respectively. The theoretical part took place in Florence (April 24, 2024). There were 11 participants from several countries: Paczkowska Katarzyna (Poland), Beltran Del Rio Hassan (Mexico), Szabó Balázs (Hungary), Soczomski Przemyslaw (Poland), Czeloth Karen (UK), Vasquez Franco Andrea (Colombia), Rührup Jessica (Switzerland), Sokol Piotr (Spain), Trusila Andrej (Belarus), Byczkiewicz Piotr (Poland), and Axelsson Jonatan (Sweden). The practical part is being carried out in the Centres of Florence and Rome. The final examination wil take place in Rome in the spring of 2025.

The next edition of the Ultrasound School will take place in the spring of 2025 – watch the EAA website for the announcement and information on how to apply.



3rd ANDRONET-EAA School in Basic Semen Examination



Training School Basic Semen Examination was run Sept 30-Oct 4. Due to limited availability of practical tutors, only four could participate this time.

All four participants passed both theory and practical exam. The course is identical with the course developed by the Special Interest Group in Andrology of ESHRE. It started on the Monday afternoon and continued with theoretical seminars and practical training until the Friday afternoon. The plan is to repeat the course next year, hopefully with some more participants.

2nd EAA School in Microsurgery

The 2nd edition of the Andrological Microsurgery School, also known as the Budapest Microsurgery Week, was organised by Zsolt Kopa and the EAA Training Centre at the Urology Department of the Semmelweis University, in Budapest, Hungary (14-18 Oct 2024).



This event featured a limited number of participants to ensure a high-quality learning experience, combining experimental microsurgical training with live surgical demonstrations.

This year, nine participants attended, selected from the waiting list, including colleagues from Mexico (2), Poland (2), Russia (1), Bulgaria (1), Slovenia (1), and Italy (2).

Next Clinical Andrologist Examination

The next examination for the EAA-endorsed Clinical Andrologist certificate will be held on 6-7 March 2025, in connection with the 6th EAA-ANDRONET Budapest School (4–6 March 2025).

Reports from other EAA-endorsed events

10th European Testicular Tumor Workshop (ETTW)

The Workshop, following the tradition of nine Copenhagen Testicular Cancer Workshops held every 3-5 years in Denmark, successfully restarted the gathering of scientists and clinicians interested in testicular cancer. The meeting was held on 9-11 October 2024 in an interesting historical venue of an old abbey located in the heart of Prague, Czech Republic.The Workshop was organised by Ludmila Boublikova (Prague University) and Kristian Almstrup (Copenhagen University, EAA member).



The comprehensive scientific programme covered practically all aspects of testicular cancer, with focus on germ cell-derived tumours: from epidemiology, genetics and epigenetics, through pathology and clinical management. Importantly, the Workshop was attended and endorsed by representatives of several international consortia, such as TECAC and MaGIC. Several EAA members were present as well, including Past President Csilla Krausz who was among the speakers.
